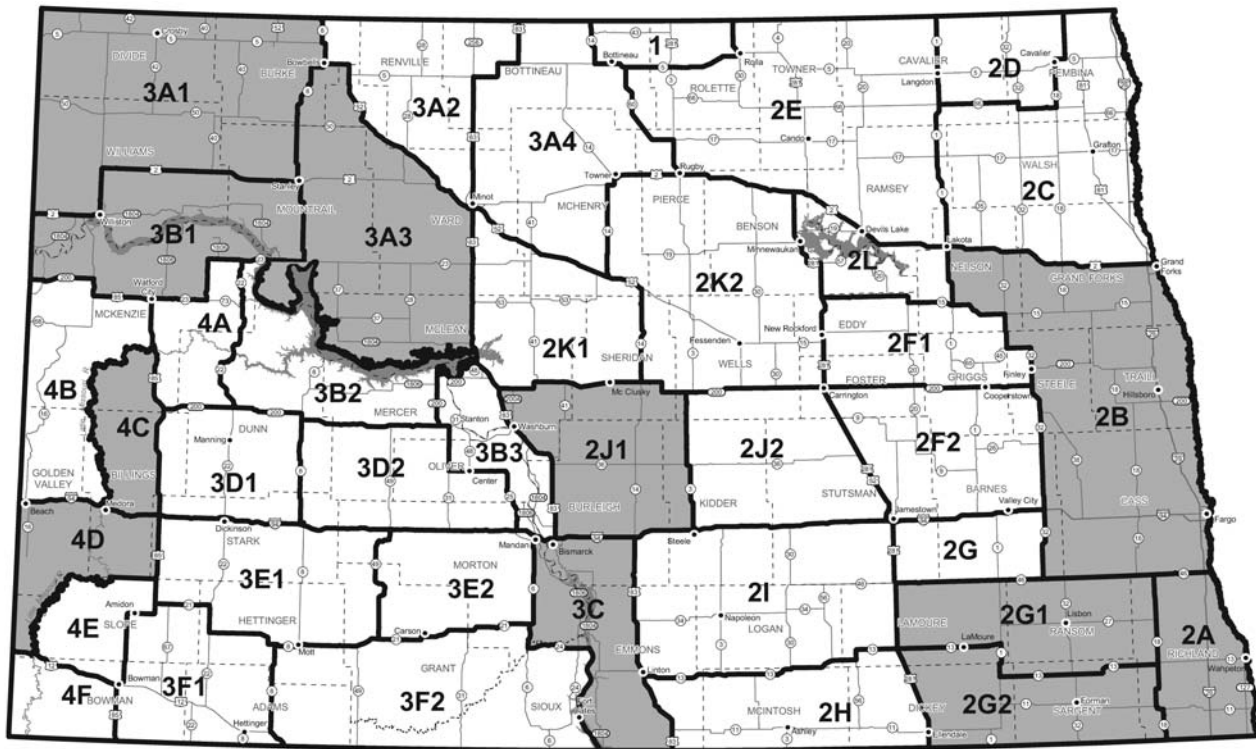




# 2009 DEER GUN HUNTING UNITS



**16 1/2 DAY SEASON — November 6 (Noon) through November 22, 2009 (Units 1, \*2C, \*2D, 2E, 2F1, 2F2, 2G, 2H, 2I, 2J2, 2K1, 2K2, 2L, 3A2, 3A4, 3B2, 3B3, 3D1, 3D2, \*3E1, \*3E2, \*3F1, \*3F2, 4A, 4B, 4E, and \*4F).**

\* (Antlerless deer license holders in Units 2C and 2D may also hunt during a Special Northeast Herd Reduction Deer Gun Season which will run from September 25 (Noon) through October 1, 2009. Antlerless deer license holders in Units 3E1, 3E2, 3F1, 3F2, and 4F may also hunt during a Special Southwest Herd Reduction Deer Gun Season which will run from October 2 (Noon) through October 9, 2009.)

**SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER REQUIREMENT.** In accordance with state law NDCC 20.1-03-35 and 42 US Code 666 (a) (13) and (16), the Department is required to collect social security numbers from all persons obtaining hunting, fishing, or other recreational type licenses. Your social security number serves as your principal identification number to determine license eligibility. It is kept confidential, however it may be provided to law enforcement agencies and the State Disbursement Unit to enforce child support obligations.

Under the weighted lottery system, you earn bonus points if you do not receive your first choice in the first lottery. You do not lose your bonus points by receiving a first come, first served license.

The NDGFD receives federal financial assistance from the US Fish and Wildlife Service.
