

# 2006 NORTH DAKOTA FISHING WATERS

Following are public fishing waters in North Dakota. Location and main fish species are provided. The counties in which the waters are located are found in parenthesis.

Waters with restrictions on boat motors and boat speeds are noted. "Idle speed only" is defined as operating a boat at the slowest speed necessary to maintain steerage (i.e., trolling – with no wake). Waters where darkhouse spearfishing is allowed are also noted. Most North Dakota public fishing waters have boat ramps. If a boat ramp is lacking, it is listed as "no ramp."

Check signs at each area for further restrictions. Use extreme caution when ice fishing on lakes with aeration systems.

- 1. Skjermo Lake** (Divide County) – 3 miles west, 4 miles northwest of Fortuna (pike, perch).
- 2. Kettle Lake** (Williams County) – 3 miles east, 2 1/2 miles north of Zahl (trout, largemouth bass, perch – fishing pier, electric motors only, seasonal restrictions, no live baitfish).
- 3. Blacktail Dam** (Williams County) – 5 miles north, 5 miles west, 1/2 mile north of the junction of highways 2 and 85 (pike, perch, bluegill – fishing pier).
- 4. Cottonwood Lake** (Williams County) – 1/2 mile east of Alamo (pike, perch – fishing pier, darkhouse spearfishing).
- 5. Upper Missouri River** – The portion of the Missouri River from Williston to the Montana state line (paddlefish, sauger, catfish).
- 6. Trenton Lake** (Williams County) – Just south of Trenton (pike, walleye, crappie).
- 7. Yellowstone River** – Near cities of Buford, Cartwright and Fairview (paddlefish, sauger, catfish – fishing pier).

- 8. Baukol-Noonan East Mine Pond** (Divide County) – 2 miles east of Noonan (trout, bluegill, largemouth bass – idle speed only).
- 9. Baukol-Noonan Dam** (Divide County) – 3 miles east, 1 mile south of Noonan (trout, bluegill, largemouth bass – idle speed only).
- 10. West Spring Lake Pond** (Williams County) – North edge of Williston (trout – no ramp, electric motors only).
- 11. East Spring Lake Pond** (Williams County) – North edge of Williston (trout – no ramp, fishing pier, electric motors only).
- 12. Short Creek Dam** (Burke County) – 5 1/2 miles north of Columbus (pike, perch, bluegill – fishing pier).
- 13. Tanberg Dam** (Divide County) – 10 miles south, 1/2 mile east, 1/2 mile south of Noonan (perch).
- 14. Epping-Springbrook Dam** (Williams County) – 1 1/2 miles east of Springbrook (pike, walleye, perch – fishing pier, idle speed only).
- 15. McGregor Dam** (Williams County) – 1 1/2 miles south of McGregor (walleye, trout, perch – fishing pier, idle speed only).
- 16. McLeod (Ray) Reservoir** (Williams County) – Southwest edge of Ray (pike, perch, walleye – fishing pier).
- 17. Sather Dam** (McKenzie County) – 11 miles south, 8 miles west of Alexander (trout, bluegill, largemouth bass – fishing pier, electric motors only, no live baitfish).
- 18. Kota-Ray Dam** (Williams County) – 5 miles south, 1/2 mile east, 2 miles south of Ray (trout, perch, largemouth bass – fishing pier, idle speed only).
- 19. Leland Dam** (McKenzie County) – 11 miles south, 8 miles west, 8 miles south, 2 miles southeast, 1 1/2 miles east, 1 mile north of Alexander (trout, bluegill, largemouth bass – electric motors only, no live baitfish).

- 20. Tioga Dam** (Williams County) – 1/2 mile north of Tioga (pike, perch, bluegill – fishing pier, darkhouse spearfishing).
- 21. Arnegard Dam** (McKenzie County) – 1 1/2 miles north, 2 miles west of Arnegard (pike, perch).
- 22. Smishek Dam** (Burke County) – 4 miles northwest of Powers Lake (pike, walleye, perch – fishing pier).
- 23. White Earth Dam** (Mountrail County) – 6 miles north of White Earth (pike, walleye, perch).
- 24. Northgate Dam** (Burke County) – 6 miles north, 1 mile west, 2 miles north, 1/2 mile west of Bowbells (walleye, trout, bluegill – fishing pier).
- 25. Powers Lake** (Burke County) – Southeast edge of Powers Lake (pike, perch – fishing pier, darkhouse spearfishing).
- 26. Iverson Dam** (Williams County) – 3 miles south, 1 mile west, 8 miles south, 1/2 mile east of Tioga (trout, largemouth bass – no ramp).
- 27. Watford City Pond** (McKenzie County) – Southeast side of Watford City (trout, bluegill, catfish – no ramp, fishing pier).
- 28. Odland Dam** (Golden Valley County) – 7 miles north of Beach (pike, perch, bluegill).
- 29. Camels Hump Dam** (Golden Valley County) – Northeast of Sentinel Butte – Exit 10 (trout, bluegill, largemouth bass – idle speed only, no live baitfish).
- 30. Nelson-Landers Pond** (Ward County) – 1/2 mile west, 1/2 mile south, 1/4 mile east of Kenaston (pike, perch).
- 31. Stanley Pond** (Mountrail County) – Northeast edge of Stanley (trout, largemouth bass – fishing pier).
- 32. Clearwater Lake** (Mountrail County) – 10 miles northeast of Stanley (pike).
- 33. Stanley Reservoir** (Mountrail County) – 1/2 mile south of Stanley (pike, perch – darkhouse spearfishing).

- 34. Lake Sakakawea** – Near cities of Williston, New Town, Garrison and Riverdale (walleye, salmon, pike, smallmouth bass – fishing pier).
- 35. Lake Darling** (Renville County) – 16 miles north, 13 miles west of Minot (pike, walleye, perch – fishing pier, check with refuge headquarters for additional regulations and restrictions).
- 36. Davis Dam** (Slope County) – 16 miles west, 4 miles north of Amidon (trout, bluegill, largemouth bass – electric motors only, no live baitfish).
- 37. Belfield Pond** (Stark County) – Southwest edge of Belfield (trout, bluegill, largemouth bass – fishing pier, no live baitfish).
- 38. Lake Ilo** (Dunn County) – 1 mile west, 1 mile south of Dunn Center (pike, perch – fishing pier, idle speed only, seasonal restrictions).
- 39. Spring Lake** (Bowman County) – 1 mile south, 4 miles west of Rhame (pike, perch).
- 40. Lutz Dam** (Bowman County) – 2 1/2 miles south, 2 miles west of Griffin (trout, bluegill, largemouth bass – no ramp).
- 41. Glenburn Pond** (Renville County) – North side of Glenburn (trout, bluegill – no ramp).
- 42. Dickinson Reservoir (Patterson Lake)** (Stark County) – 2 miles west of Dickinson (pike, walleye, crappie – fishing pier).
- 43. Dickinson Dike** (Stark County) – Southwest edge of Dickinson (trout, bluegill, largemouth bass – fishing pier, electric motors only, no live baitfish).
- 44. Makoti Lake** (Ward County) – 5 miles south of Makoti (pike, perch).
- 45. Hiddenwood Lake** (Ward County) – 7 miles south of Makoti (pike, walleye, perch – fishing pier).
- 46. Kalina Dam** (Bowman County) – 2 miles west, 1 mile south, 1 mile west, 1 mile south of Bowman (pike, perch, bluegill – no ramp).
- 47. Rice Lake** (Ward County) – 4 miles north, 5 miles east, 1 mile north of Ryder (pike, perch, walleye).
- 48. Pathway Pond** (Ward County) – North end of state fairgrounds (trout, bluegill – no ramp, fishing pier, open to fishing during daylight hours only).
- 49. Strawberry Lake** (Bottineau County) – 4 miles north, 2 1/2 miles east, 1/2 mile south of Carbury (trout – fishing pier, electric motors only).
- 50. Carbury Dam** (Bottineau County) – 1 mile south, 1 mile west of Carbury (pike, perch – fishing pier, idle speed only).
- 51. North Carlson Lake** (Ward County) – 8 miles east of Ryder (pike).
- 52. South Carlson Lake** (Ward County) – 8 miles east of Ryder (pike, perch – fishing pier, idle speed only).
- 53. Lake Metigoshe** (Bottineau County) – 1 mile east, 13 miles north, 2 miles east of Bottineau (pike, walleye, perch – fishing pier).
- 54. Cedar Lake** (Slope County) – 13 miles north, 2 miles west of Reeder (pike, perch).
- 55. Bowman-Haley Dam** (Bowman County) – 11 miles south, 8 miles east, 2 miles south of Bowman (walleye, perch, smallmouth bass – fishing pier).
- 56. Gascoyne Lake** (Bowman County) – 1 1/2 miles northwest of Gascoyne (pike).
- 57. Pelican Lake** (Bottineau County) – 1 mile east, 11 miles north, 6 miles east, 1 mile southwest of Bottineau (pike, perch – idle speed only).
- 58. Long Lake** (Bottineau County) – 1 mile east, 11 miles north, 4 miles east, 1 mile south, 3 miles east, 1 mile south, 1 mile west of Bottineau (pike, walleye, perch – aeration system).
- 59. Buffalo Lodge Lake** (McHenry County) – 1 mile east, 3 miles north, 2 miles east of Granville (pike, walleye, perch – fishing pier, darkhouse spearfishing).
- 60. Harmony Lake** (Mercer County) – 6 miles north, 1 mile west of Hazen (bluegill, largemouth bass – electric motors only).
- 61. Beulah Mine Pond** (Mercer County) – 2 miles north, 2 1/2 miles east, 1/2 mile north of Beulah (perch – no ramp).
- 62. Indian Creek Dam** (Hettinger County) – 1 1/2 miles west, 2 miles south, 2 miles west, 3 miles south of Regent (walleye, bluegill, smallmouth bass – fishing pier, idle speed only, no live baitfish).
- 63. Carpenter Lake** (Rolette County) – 12 miles west of St. John (pike, perch – no ramp, darkhouse spearfishing).
- 64. Larson Lake** (Hettinger County) – 1/2 mile north and 2 miles east of Regent (pike, perch).
- 65. School Section Lake** (Rolette County) – 9 miles north, 2 1/2 miles east of Dunseith (pike, perch – darkhouse spearfishing).
- 66. Custer Mine** (McLean County) – 4 miles east, 2 miles south of Garrison (trout – no live baitfish).
- 67. Jensen Lake** (Rolette County) – 9 miles west, 3 miles north of St. John (trout, perch – idle speed only).
- 68. Camp Loop Pond** (McLean County) – 3 miles southwest of Riverdale at Army Corps of Engineers' downstream campground (trout – no ramp).
- 69. Velva Sportsmen's Pond** (Ward County) – 7 miles south, 1 1/2 miles west, 1 mile south, 1/2 mile west of Velva (trout – no live baitfish).
- 70. Riverdale Spillway Lake** (McLean County) – 2 miles west, 1/2 mile south, 1 mile east of Riverdale (walleye, perch, crappie – idle speed only).
- 71. Riverdale City Pond** (McLean County) – North side of Riverdale (trout, bluegill, largemouth bass – no ramp, fishing pier).
- 72. Dion Lake** (Rolette County) – 10 miles west, 2 miles north, 1 mile east of St. John (walleye, perch – fishing pier, idle speed only).
- 73. Shutte Lake** (Rolette County) – 1/2 mile east of Dunseith (pike, perch – no ramp).
- 74. Hooker Lake** (Rolette County) – 8 miles west of St. John (trout, smallmouth bass – fishing pier, idle speed only).
- 75. Cain Lake** (Rolette County) – 2 miles south, 9 miles west, 1/2 mile north of St. John (pike, perch – no ramp, reservation permit required).
- 76. Upsilon Lake** (Rolette County) – 6 miles west, 1 mile north of St. John (pike, walleye, perch – fishing pier).
- 77. Gravel Lake** (Rolette County) – 6 miles west, 1/2 mile north of St. John (pike, walleye, perch – fishing pier, idle speed only).
- 78. Jarvis Lake** (Rolette County) – 3/4 mile southwest, 6 miles west of St. John (pike, walleye, perch – no ramp, reservation permit required).
- 79. Lake Audubon** (McLean County) – North of Coleharbor (walleye, perch, smallmouth bass – fishing pier, idle speed only on north arm).
- 80. Castle Rock Dam** (Hettinger County) – 2 miles west, 1 1/2 miles south, 1 1/2 miles west of Mott (trout, largemouth bass).
- 81. Mott Watershed Dam** (Hettinger County) – North side of Mott (bluegill, largemouth bass – fishing pier).
- 82. Wheaton Lake** (Rolette County) – 4 1/2 miles north, 2 miles west of Belcourt (walleye, perch – reservation permit required).
- 83. Gordon Lake** (Rolette County) – 4 1/2 miles north, 1 mile west, 1/4 mile northwest of Belcourt (pike, walleye, perch – reservation permit required).
- 84. Belcourt Lake** (Rolette County) – 2 miles north of Belcourt (pike, walleye, perch – reservation permit required).
- 85. Mirror Lake** (Adams County) – On south side of Hettinger (pike, perch, bluegill – fishing pier, idle speed only).
- 86. Strawberry Lake** (McLean County) – 17 1/2 miles north, 2 miles east of Turtle Lake (pike, walleye, perch – aeration system).
- 87. Camp Lake** (McLean County) – 17 1/2 miles north, 2 miles east of Turtle Lake (pike, perch – no ramp).
- 88. Blickensderfer Dam** (Hettinger County) – 4 miles south, 1 mile east, 1/2 mile south of Mott (walleye, perch, bluegill – no ramp, walking access only).
- 89. Long Lake** (McLean County) – 13 miles north, 2 miles east of Turtle Lake (pike).
- 90. Crooked Lake** (McLean County) – 11 miles north, 1/2 mile east of Turtle Lake (pike, walleye, perch).
- 91. Cottonwood Lake** (McHenry County) – 2 1/2 miles north of Butte (pike, perch – fishing pier).



- 112. North Lemmon** (Adams County) – 5 miles north of Lemmon, S.D. (trout, bluegill, largemouth bass – fishing pier, no live baitfish).
- 113. Missouri River** – The portion of the Missouri River from near Riverdale to near Bismarck (walleye, catfish, trout – fishing pier).
- 114. Sweet Briar Dam** (Morton County) – 18 miles west of Mandan – Exit 134 (walleye, perch, bluegill – fishing pier, idle speed only).
- 115. GDU Canal Lakes** – Includes New Johns (Burleigh County), Heckers (Sheridan County) and East and West Park (McLean County) lakes – 9 miles south and three miles east and west of Mercer (walleye, perch, smallmouth bass).
- 116. Antelope Lake** (Pierce County) – 8 miles west, 3 miles south, 5 miles west, 2 miles south of Esmond (perch, walleye – no ramp).
- 117. Bentz Lake** (Sheridan County) – 11 miles north of McClusky (perch – no ramp).



- 118. Bisbee Dam-Big Coulee** (Towner County) – 1 mile east of Bisbee (pike, walleye, perch – fishing pier).
- 119. North (Hoffer) McClusky** (Sheridan County) – 2 miles north, 1 mile west of McClusky (pike, perch – no ramp).

- 139. Silver Lake** (Benson County) – 1 mile west, 6 miles south, 1 mile west, 1 mile north of Churchs Ferry (pike, perch – no ramp, seasonal restrictions, darkhouse spearfishing).
- 140. Twin Lakes** (Burleigh County) – 7 miles west, 5 miles north of Tuttle (perch – no ramp, winter fishing).
- 141. Hurdsfield Lake** (Wells County) – 3 1/2 miles east of Hurdsfield (perch – no ramp).

- 162. Lake No. 5** (Kidder County) – 1/2 mile west, 2 miles north, 3 miles west, 4 miles north of Dawson (perch – no ramp).
- 163. Lake Williams** (Kidder County) – Just south of the town of Lake Williams (pike, walleye, perch).
- 164. Wood Lake** (Benson County) – 2 miles west, 1 mile south of Tokio (pike, walleye, perch).
- 165. Braddock Dam** (Emmons County) – 2 miles southwest of Braddock (pike).
- 166. McPhail WMA** (Kidder County) – 7 miles north, 2 miles west of Tappen (perch – no ramp).
- 167. Round Lake** (Kidder County) – 1 1/2 miles east of Pettibone (pike, walleye, perch – no ramp, darkhouse spearfishing).
