

FISHERIES AIDES – TEMPORARY, SEASONAL

JOB DURATION

3 months (mid-May through August) but may be up to 11 months depending on need.



ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Assist fisheries personnel with reproduction and population test netting, trap and transport of different fish species, limnological sampling, spawning activities and may involve data compilation. This includes loading and unloading boats, nets and other equipment.
- Assist with habitat enhancement.
- Equipment, building and gear maintenance (includes net repair).
- Overnight travel required (vehicles provided). Expenses while away from main work station will be reimbursed (includes motel and meals).
- Individual must be able to work outdoors in varying weather conditions.
- Opportunities are also found with our fisheries development program (boat ramps, docks and piers) and national fish hatcheries.
- Creel clerk duties.



PAYSCALE AND HOUSING

Ranges from \$9.85 - \$14.70 per hour. Housing is available at all locations except Valley City.



MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicant must be enrolled in, or a recent graduate of, a college or university majoring in a biology-related field. Students should be in good academic standing. Must be able to lift at least 50 pounds above their head and possess a valid driver's license.
