

Bakken Development and Working Lands Program II (BDWLP)



FOR LANDOWNERS IN OIL-PRODUCING COUNTIES

Assistance with:

- Developing prescribed grazing strategies.
- Recommendations for cover crops well-suited for grazing and soil quality rehabilitation.
- Seed-mix recommendations for native and tame grass seedings.
- Establishing vegetation and habitat around energy development sites.

Cost-share on:

- Grass seeding, which may include payment during the establishment phase.
- Installation of range infrastructure.
- Implementation of restoration activities.

GRAZING & SEEDING PROJECTS

- 60/40 Cost-share on fencing & water.
- Assistance with cover crop planning and grass seeding for soil quality rehabilitation.
- Payment while native grass seeding gets established.
- Creation of map for infrastructure installation.
- Cultural review assistance.



AGRICULTURE / ENERGY SITE PROJECTS



- Cost-share for vegetative cover establishment adjacent to or “square-off” well pads/energy sites.
- Ideal for wildlife habitat creation areas.
