

AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE TO THE 2016-2017
SMALL GAME, WATERFOWL, AND FURBEARER PROCLAMATION

2017 SPRING LIGHT GOOSE HUNTING SEASON

The following sections of the 2016-2017 Small Game-Furbearer Proclamation as amended and dated August 1, 2016 are amended for the 2017 Spring Light Goose Hunting Season to read as follows.

10. LICENSES OR SPECIAL PERMITS.

Resident hunters must possess a valid current hunting certificate, a small game license, a general game and habitat license, or a combination license. 2016-2017 licenses expire on March 31, 2017.


Non-resident hunters only need a 2017 non-resident spring light goose license.

A Federal Duck Stamp is not required.

All migratory game bird hunters must be certified through the Harvest Information Program (HIP) for 2017.

38. GEESE. Light geese include snow geese (white and blue phase) and Ross's geese. Light geese may be taken statewide from February 18, 2017 - May 14, 2017. There shall be no daily or possession limit on light geese.
39. SHOOTING HOURS. Shooting hours for 2017 Spring Light Goose Hunting Season shall be from one-half hour before sunrise to one-half hour after sunset each day.
42. ELECTRONIC CALLS AND FIREARMS. Electronic and recorded calls as well as shotguns capable of holding in excess of 3 shells may be used to take light geese during the 2017 Spring Light Goose Hunting Season.
