

2010 Waterfowl Rest Area Proclamation

Pursuant to law and the recommendation of the Game and Fish Director, I hereby declare certain areas as Waterfowl Rest Areas from September 25, 2010 through December 31, 2010. All Waterfowl Rest Areas listed below shall be closed to goose or waterfowl hunting during this period, and closed to small game hunting and fishing from September 25, 2010 through November 30, 2010, except as hereinafter specified below. All Waterfowl Rest Areas will be open to fishing and hunting on December 1, 2010 but remain closed to goose or waterfowl hunting. Waterfowl Rest Areas will remain open through the end of the respective seasons.

WATERFOWL REST AREAS

BARNES COUNTY:

(1) Sec. 1, E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 11, N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 12, Twp. 143, Rge. 60. Open to fishing.

BURKE COUNTY:

(1) Sec. 36, Twp. 164, Rge. 93.

CAVALIER COUNTY:

(1) Those portions of Sec. 20, Sec. 27, Sec. 28, and Sec. 29, Twp. 163, Rge. 59 owned by the Cavalier County Water Management Board and posted as a Waterfowl Rest Area.

DIVIDE COUNTY:

(1) Sec. 15; that part of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 16 east of Hwy 40; Sec. 22; that part of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 21 east of Hwy 40; Twp. 163, Rge. 95.

HETTINGER COUNTY:

(1) Mott Reservoir in N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 35, Twp. 134, Rge. 93. Closed to waterfowl hunting only.

KIDDER COUNTY:

(1) Pursian Lake - Sec. 14, and N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 23, Twp. 137, Rge. 74. Closed to all hunting.

LAMOURE COUNTY:

(1) Cottonwood Lake - The creek, the meandered portion of the lake, and that part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 35 lying north and east of the creek; and Sec. 36, except the E $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$, and that portion of Lot 2 lying east of the fence, Twp. 133, Rge. 62. Closed to all hunting.

MERCER COUNTY

(See MCLEAN COUNTY)

MCLEAN COUNTY :

(1) **Missouri River**--An area enclosed by the following boundaries: Starting at the east bank of the Missouri River at the mouth of Turtle Creek south of Washburn, thence north along the east bank of the Missouri River to Garrison Dam, thence west along the face of the dam to the west bank of the Missouri River, thence south along the west bank of the Missouri River to a point directly west of the mouth of Turtle Creek, and thence east to the point of origin. (Portions in Mercer, McLean, and Oliver Counties.) Closed to goose hunting only.

NELSON COUNTY:

(1) Lake Pickard - S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 26; and Sec. 35, Twp. 152, Rge. 57. Open to fishing.

(2) E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 34, Twp. 152, Rge. 59. Closed to waterfowl hunting only.

(3) Lake Larreta - All of Sec. 13 and Sec. 24, except NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ beyond meander line of Sec. 13, Twp. 153, Rge. 59.

OLIVER COUNTY:

(See MCLEAN COUNTY)

PEMBINA COUNTY:

(See WALSH COUNTY)

ROLETTE COUNTY:

(See TOWNER COUNTY)

(1) All of Sec. 35, Twp. 161, Rge. 71. Closed to waterfowl hunting only.

SHERIDAN COUNTY:

(1) The meandered portion of Sheyenne Lake in Sec. 23, Sec. 24, Sec. 25, and Sec. 26, Twp. 149, Rge. 75 and in Sec. 30, Twp. 149, Rge. 74.

STEELE COUNTY:

(1) North Golden Lake - Sec. 35, Twp. 148, Rge. 55; and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 2, Twp. 147, Rge. 55.

STUTSMAN COUNTY:

(1) Sec. 25 and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 36, Twp. 141, Rge. 67. Closed to waterfowl hunting only.

TOWNER COUNTY:

(1) NW¹/₄, SE¹/₄, W¹/₂W¹/₂NE¹/₄, and N¹/₂SW¹/₄ of Sec. 18, Twp. 162, Rge. 68; NE¹/₄ and N¹/₂SE¹/₄ of Sec. 13, Twp. 162, Rge. 69 (Portion of *ROLETTE COUNTY*).

WALSH COUNTY:

(1) The meandered portion of North Salt Lake in Sec. 3; Sec. 4; Sec. 10, Twp. 158, Rge. 52, and Sec. 33; Sec. 34, Twp. 159, Rge. 52.
