

\$2,000 REWARD

North Dakota Game and Fish Department officials are looking for information in connection to a moose poaching case earlier this spring in the north-eastern part of the state.

Five adult moose – three cows and two bulls – were shot and killed sometime around April 25 through April 30 about 6 miles southwest of Dunseith. According to law enforcement, one adult moose, a large cow, was pregnant with triplets, with two calves cut out of her.
